
- Partial sunny spells possible during the morning.






ATHLETES PRESENTATION

- Access pre-start area 8min before start
- There is not cover, pls use rain jacket and/or umbrellas
- Present at pre-start area 5min before start
- Line up at entry gate 3:30min before start
- Start Athletes Presentation 3:00min before start
- 10 seconds per team
 - Female athlete: racesuit, skis in hand, walking to start position, stepping into binding at start position
 - Male athlete: jacket, no equipment, walks from entry gate straight to exit the start area
- End Athletes Presentation 1:00min before the start
- Move to start line position when called by speaker
- -12 to start: start procedure



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BIB AND TIMING CHIP POSITION

FRONT

BACK



LEFT LEG BIB POSITION

Bottom edge of the right bib should be approximately 5cm above the top of the kneecap.

The bib should be orientated on the front of the leg.



RIGHT LEG BIB POSITION

Bottom edge of the left bib should be approximately 5cm above the top of the kneecap.

The bib should be orientated on the side (outside) of the leg.

TIMING CHIP POSITION

One, per leg positioned above the upper edge of the boot and below the knee cap.

RETURN OF CHIPS AT ENTRY TO TPA

VICTORY CEREMONY

- Celebration and toblerone shot at finish area
- Get dressed with jacket
- OBS interview
- Get fully dressed for Victory Ceremony
- Female athletes, once they finish their loop, should stand in the space between the start and the finish
- Ceremonies:
 - Victory Ceremony
 - Samsung selfie
 - Equipment Podium – photo opportunity: ski, poles, goggles, flags





DID NOT START (DNS)

- It is the responsibility of the athlete or their team captain to officially communicate a DNS status to either the ISMF Jury President or his designated representative.
- This communication must occur as soon as the decision not to start is known and can be made verbally or in writing.
- If the bib has not yet been collected: the team captain must confirm at the TCM that the athlete/team will not start.
- If the bib has already been collected: the DNS must be communicated in person together with the return of the transponder.

ABANDONMENT OF AN ATHLETE

- An athlete having difficulties may give up on his/her own initiative or be forced to give up by decision of the LOC Race Director or one of the doctors present on site.
- Giving up (by own initiative or forced) must take place at a checkpoint or waypoint according to the procedure described during the TCM except under extreme circumstances. For team races, if one team member gives up then the other will be told to give up and must follow instructions given by the controllers.
- Every athlete having withdrawn **MUST** inform the ISMF Jury President (or his representative) upon arrival at the finish area. The athletes having withdrawn may also be subject to doping control.



YELLOW FLAG

Warning: the competition continues without interruption. Athletes are warned to exercise caution due to a potential danger or obstruction on the course. The YELLOW flag may be displayed by FOP workforce members as required.



Usage of it depends on the ISMF Jury.

COURSE ACCESS – ARMBANDS

BLUE

Teams – Access to coaches areas
3 armband per NOC

LIGHT BLUE

Jury – Access to FOP

YELLOW

Workforce – Access to FOP



RESTRICTED AREA/TEAM PREPARATION ACCESS

Sticker given at the end of the meeting



- Use common sense for Team Preparation Area (indoor and limited space).
- 1 representative to accompany athlete to start area or Handover Area.
- 1 representative per Coaching Area (crampons or snowchasing required):
 - 2 armbands at the TCM Sprint Race
 - +1 armband at the TCM Mixed Relay Race
- Return after Mixed Relay Race at Equipment Control Container.
- 1 representative per Track Inspection (no armband required – checklist to be used).

EQUIPMENT CONTROL

Location:

- **21 February:** Equipment Control Area on FoP (next to the entrance to the Start Area)
- In case stickers need to be replaced – spare bibs distribution if needed





BIBS AND TRANSPONDER DISTRIBUTION
